

THE LITTLE PRINCE - AUDITION FORM (MINOR CHILD)

SHOW: The Mud Creek Players is partnering with The ACT, an MCP youth outreach initiative. The ACT participants (ages 13-18) will be directly involved in all aspects of production (design, building, crafting, etc.). Any adults involved must come to the production with a young and generous heart! The ACT kids will also be writing and performing a one act play as a pre-show to *The Little Prince*.

CASTING: The Aviator must be able to carry a medium-sized, sleeping child in his arms for several minutes. The Prince may be a boy or girl (or small woman), preferably willing to cut and/or dye their hair blond. We will consider wigs as an option if necessary. In addition to the two main characters (Aviator and Prince), there are featured roles (Fox, Snake, Rose) as well as several smaller speaking and non-speaking ensemble opportunities. Ensemble cast members will be on stage much of the time, their bodies creating the scenic elements in unique and creative ways.
